Italy

20. **Soave Classico DOC “Brognoligo” 2008**
Cecilia Beretta
A stunning wine showing what yardstick Soave is all about – ripe, warm, semi tropical fruit, bone dry and truly satisfying 18.50
21. **Pinot Grigio “Grigio Luna” IGT Venezia 2010**
Cecilia Beretta
Exceptional – a hitherto unknown balance of grilled almonds with gooseberries, citrus fruits and a subtle underlying minerality. Excellent single vineyard wine. 19.50

Germany

25. **Schloss Schonborn Estate Riesling 2009**
A great Rheingau Estate with a history going back 600 years, 2006 had perfect ripening conditions which is reflected in this quality wine. Excellent with fish such as trout and salmon. 18.50

Spain

30. **Vina Garedo 2009**
Rueda DO
This wine has an interesting clean fruit aroma scented and perfumed with full fresh citrus fruit and a nutty minerally flavour. 17.25
31. **Veigardares Albarino 2002, Adegas Galegas, Galicia**
*Recently voted by the International Wine Challenge as the finest Albarino on the market.
From Galicia in NW Spain – wonderfully stony, minerally fruit of terrific elegance.
Considered to one of the greatest wine partners for fish.* 32.00
32. **Gallocanto Blanco 2003, Benjamin Romeo (Rioja)**
*Arguably the rarest white Rioja to be found on the market here or in any other country, as miniscule amounts of this wine are made. Romeo is probably the most specialist Rioja producer, whose great reds command huge prices.
Rich and finely balanced, this oaked rioja is stunning and a must for those who love their Riojas.* £37.50

Australia

40. **The Gatekeeper/ Simon Hackett Chardonnay 2009**
Barossa Valley
This is luscious and full bodied, a combination of fresh citrus, exotic fruit with a creamy rich texture, emphasised by lightly handled oak 19.95
41. **Eagle Vale Semillon Sauvignon Blanc 2007**
Margaret River
A refreshing, clean classically Margaret River style, with crisp, zesty citrus and plenty of complex rich fruit. Well-balanced. 21.50

New Zealand

45. **Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc 2010**
This famous wine has been written about since it was first released onto the market. Pale straw green in colour and piercingly aromatic it shows all the characteristics of an excellent Marlborough season. 45.00

South Africa

50. **Old Vines Chenin Blanc 2009**
Stellenbosch WO
The refined balance of ripe fruit, crisp vitality and background honey, quince and spice complement lightly spiced dishes beautifully. 18.95

South America

55. **Mendoza Pinot Gris 2009**
Bodega Lurton, Argentina
A wine of real character, rich in stone fruit, fresh, with delicate raisin notes 17.95

60. **Bourgogne Rose Cuvee Margoton 2008, Olivier Leflaive**
named in honour of Olivier's little girl, brightly fruited
it combines roses and sweet spice which is aromatic, fruity
and exuberant.

- 102.. **Chateau Mayne-Graves, 2007**
Superior merlot blend. Dry medium bodied wine with Good rich colour and red fruit flavours. 22.50
103. **Chateau La Courolle 2007**
Montagne St. Emilion
Wonderfully supple, sappy cherry-rich blend which coats the palate. Very keenly balanced, it has a sensual, silky texture. 25.50
104. **Chateau La Courolle 2007** Half Bottles 14.75
105. **L'Hospitalet de Gazin 2006 Pomerol**
The immediate neighbour of Petrus. This was a great success in 2003. "The nose is lovely, rich in sweet, gamey, toasted red fruit whilst the palate is succulent, supple and rich with generous structure and full, satisfying finish" 45.00
106. **L'Orangie de Carignan 2007**
Premieres Cotes de Bordeaux
From the estates younger vines giving spicy top notes on a ripe blackcurrnt and raspberry under tone. A very good value Premiere Cotes de Bordeaux ready to drink now 25.95
107. **L'Orangerie de Carignan 2007** Half Bottles 13.50
- 110 **Chateau de Lamarque 2002**
Situated on the left bank of the Gironde this Haut-Medoc is just north of Margeaux. An impressive plum, cassis and pencil lead nose with well-integrated new oak, good value classical claret. 28.50

- 111 **Chateau Potensac 2005**
A first class wine from a first class vintage. Ch. Potensac comes from the same stable as Ch. Leoville Las Cases and Ch. Nenin as they are all owned by the Delon Family. Deeply coloured, plenty of body, attractive blackcurrant flavours, earthy nose, classically structured with a long finish. At its peak for drinking now. 47.50
- 112 **Chateau Bel-Air 2004**
From the tiny appellation Grave de Vayres, this is a claret lovers claret. Traditional in style with an emphasis on balance 21.60

French Country Wines

115. **Domaine de Mountauberon, Merlot 2006**
soft fruity, ruby red typical merlot, easy drinking 16.50

Burgundy

- 120 Bourgogne Rouge Les Grands Chaillots, 2004
Domaine Marchard de Gramont
Vibrant red fruit, full red colour, fragrant nose with dusty black fruit on the palate, very drinkable 25.50
- 121 **Bourgogne Pinot Noir Domaine Cyrot-Buthiau 2008**
as above **Half Bottle** 14.95
122. **Gevrey Chambertin Champonnets 1er Cru 2000**
Domaine des Varoilles
Medium red from hand picked grapes, lovely high toned nose over sweet red cherry. Good, smooth finish Wonderful with venison and game. 45.00

Rhone

- 125 **Crozes Hermitage le Millepertuis 2007, Domaine Guyot**
Elegant, full bodied red with peppery juicy dark fruits with spices to finish excellent with red meat. 28.50

Spain

130. **Laguna de la Nava Reserva 2005**
Rioja style, tempranillo, Rich garnet in colour, this presents a blend of autumnal fruit, leather notes and vanilla cream. 20.50
131. **Bodegas Duron Crianza 2006**
Ribera del Duero DO
Rich plum in colour with black cherries and vanilla on the nose, a full bodied, rich palate with a long finish. 26.50
- 132 **Rioja Gran Reserva 2001, Solar de Samenigo**
when many of the Rioja producers changed their style in the 1980s a few of the best retained their traditional style, much prized in the Rioja region. An elegant, reserved style, achieved by extended oak ageing. 38.00
- 134 **Rioja Crianza 2006, Solar de Samaniego, half bottle**
Dried fruit, ripe prune and light oak aroma gives a full bodied popular drink. 14.25

Italy

- 136 **Chianti Classico DOCG "Terre di Prenzano" 2007**
Vignamaggio
Modern and freshly fruited this 100% Sangiovese offers plump cherries and plums laced with vanilla. 23.95
- 137 **Amarone della Valpolicella Classico Vigneti Casterna 2005, Pasqua**
from the Veneto region of Italy close to Lake Garda. The dried raisin like grapes make this an intensely fruited, multi-layered, spicy rich wine. Very fine vintage. 42.00
- 138 **Barolo Classico 2000, Prunotto**
one of the great producers of this exquisite wine from the hills of Piedmont in NW Italy. Produced from the Nebbiolo grape this is a big rich savoury wine. Superb vintage. 45.00

RED WINES (cont'd)

Australia

151. **The Gatekeeper Cabernet Sauvignon 2006**
McLaren Valley
A Bordeaux grape producing a robust Australian wine with both depth and sweetness of fruit – perfect with stews, casseroles and spicy foods. 19.95
152. **Eagle Vale Shiraz 2005, Whispering Lake**
Margaret River
Rich plum in colour this is a very refined, elegant Shiraz, very aromatic with floral notes and rich black cherries complemented by a heady dash of pepper. 28.50

New Zealand

161. **Muddy Water Pinot Noir 2008**
Richly coloured, ripe sweet fruit character, concentrated Flavours of plums and toasty oak, complex and rounded 29.50
162. **Eradus Pinot Noir 2009**
The Berloft vineyard Marlborough is situated between the Southern Alps and the Pacific Ocean giving a warm growing season. This wine has hints of black cherry, strawberry and plum flavours that have combined with the fine grain tannins to produce a wine of exceptional palate length. 23.75

South Africa

165. **Bainskloof Merlot 2008**
Breede River
ripe cherries and cassis, laced with pepper – really attractive, effortless drinking. 18.95

Americas

170. **Malbec 2007**
Bodega Ruca Malen, Mendoza, Argentina
10 months in oak adds weight and complexity to this blackfruited, richly concentrated Malbec,. intense and very fine. 19.95
- 171 **Vina Mar Pinot Noir 2009.** *Boutique winery in Chile's cool oceanic Casablanca valley. Delicate red cherry and strawberry notes.* 22.50
- 171.A **Beaulieu Vineyards, California, Pinot Noir 2003**
red cherry berry and spices, light excellent to accompany salmon or cheese 22.50
172. **Edmeades Zinfandel 2004**
Mendocino, California
This is a big, full-bodied wine, with concentrated ripe, soft berry fruit, a touch of spice and oak and a lovely light tannic structure. 28.50

200. **Corney & Barrow's Sparkling Blanc de Blancs
Varichon et Clerc, Methode Traditionelle**
*Bottle-fermented in the traditional fashion this is a
rather stylish, crisp wine with delicate biscuit notes.* 21.50
201. **'Pink' Yellow Glen Australian Sparkling Wine**
*Popular sparkling wine, pinot wine and chardonnay,
smooth medium dry, a refreshing drink.* 16.50
203. **Pelorus**
*The sparkling wine from renowned New Zealand
Winery. Made from classic champagne grapes of
Pinot Noir and Chardonnay – classy with apple
fruit flavours and a toasty roundness on the palate.* 26.50
204. **Moet & Chandon N.V. Brut Imperial**
*Golden in colour, fruit and honeysuckle aromas,
complex champagne with great depth.* 45.00
205. **Pelorus Pinot Noir Vintage 2002**
*Probably the best sparkling wine of the New World.
Mellow, satisfying, deliciously complex and
'biscuity'.* 29.50
